

Help with drug costs - Low Income Subsidy

"Extra Help" is a Medicare program to help people with limited income and resources pay Medicare drug coverage (Part D) premiums, deductibles, coinsurance, and other costs. You also won't have to pay a Part D late enrollment penalty while you get Extra Help. What's the Part D penalty?

You may be eligible for help paying for some or all of your prescription drug costs, based on guidelines set by the federal government. You can apply for this help through the Social Security Administration or a state Medical Assistance Office. The amount of assistance you receive, if any, will depend on your income and resources, and is determined by the federal government. If you think you could qualify for help, call the Social Security Administration at 1-800-772-1213 (TTY/TDD 1-800-325-0778), between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, or visit Social Security Website. The Social Security Administration's application process provides the quickest decision. (You can also go to a local Social Security Administration or Medicaid office and apply.)
